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1. System requirements

1. Bandwidth requirements

Teams is designed to give the best audio, video, and content sharing experience regardless of your network conditions. That said, when bandwidth is insufficient, Teams prioritizes audio quality over video quality.

NOTE: Minimum requirements for taking the test. If more than one candidate shares the link during the exam, the total required bandwidth (down/up) is the number of candidates multiplied by minimum requirement.

1.2 Requirements for Teams on a PC

Memory	2.0 GB RAM
Hard disk	3.0 GB of available disk space
Display	1920 x 1080 Full HD minimal resolution Display size from 14"-27"
Graphics	Minimum of 128 MB graphics memory
Operating system	Windows: Windows Server 2012 R2+, Windows 10, or Windows 8.1 in 32-bit and 64-bit. Linux: Linux distribution capable of installing DEB or RPM Mac: Mac OS X 10.11 El Capitan or later
.NET version	Requires .NET 4.5 CLR or later
Video	USB 2.0 video camera; minimum 0.3Mp(640x480), recommended 720p HD Camera (1280 x 720)
Devices	Standard microphone and speakers



2. Initial instructions for downloading and logging in to Microsoft Teams and Outlook

In order to successfully start using the Microsoft Teams application, you need to download from the link that follows:

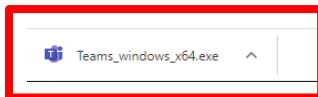

It is then necessary to start the installation by clicking on ***Teams_windows_64.exe*** (shown in the image above).

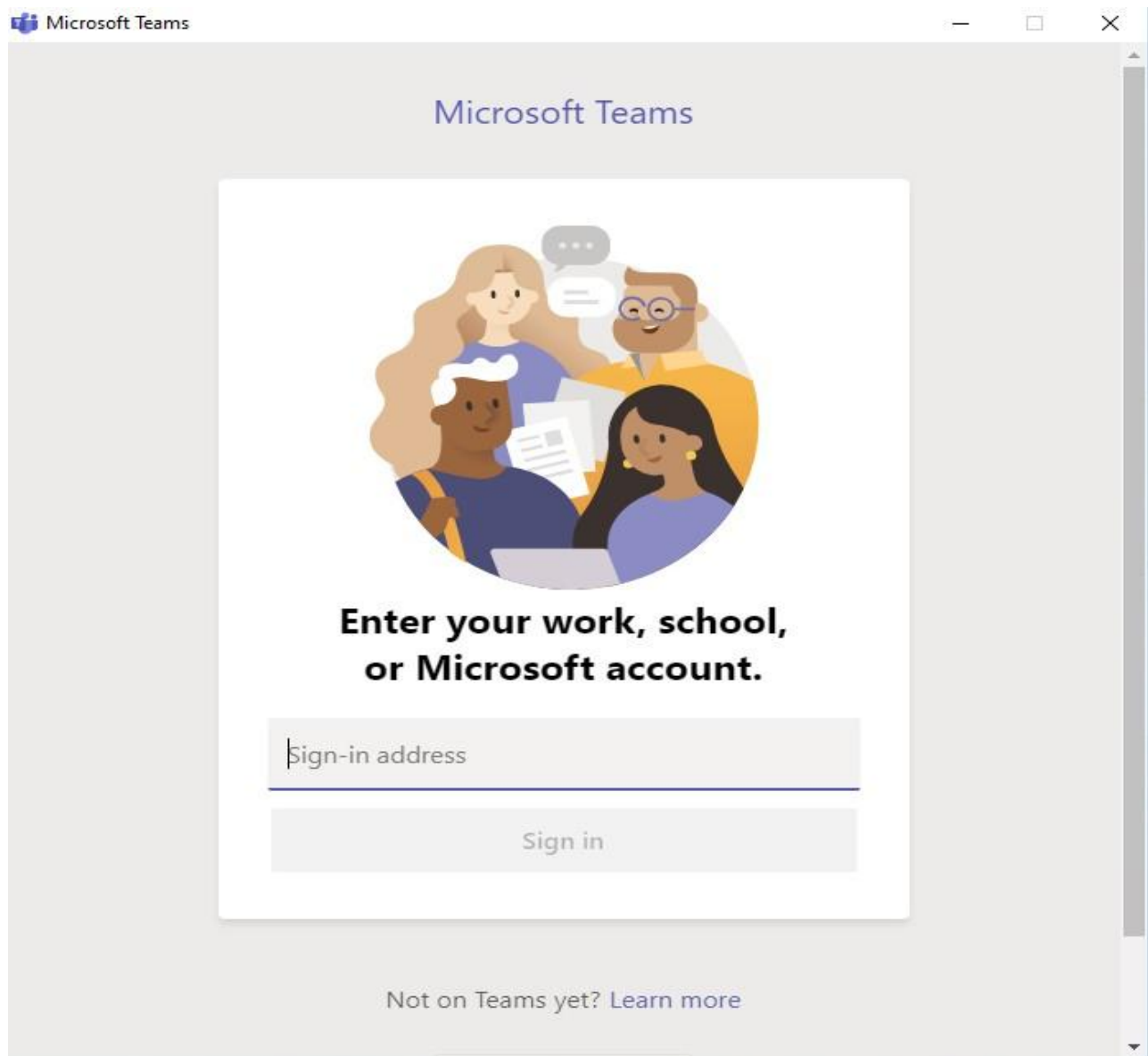
When the Microsoft Teams installation is complete, you need to log in with your credentials, which are in the format:

- From your web browser, go to the Office 365 portal via the following link:

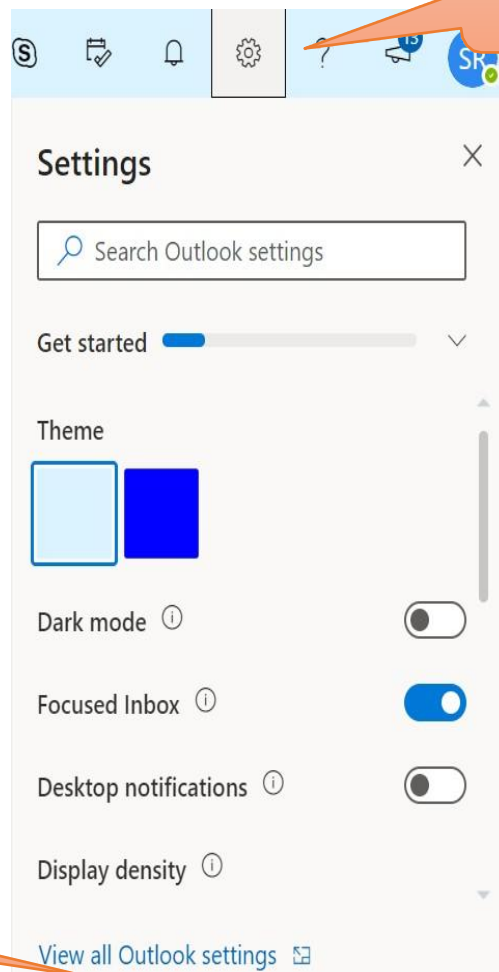

To configure Time zone – settings - go to:
